<p>Our art and design curriculum intends to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Foster interest and curiosity for art and design which inspires pupils. ✓ Offer pupils rich and diverse learning experiences through individual sessions, curriculum art days and through longer sequences of cross-curricular projects. ✓ Offer pupils a wide range of opportunities in utilising and applying their skills with various resources, media and art equipment. ✓ Foster a love and appreciation of art by offering pupils the chance to pose questions, explore art and the work of artists and be open-minded about what they might see and experience. ✓ Support the development of key language skills in relation to describing/ interpreting art. ✓ Provide opportunities for pupils to engage in discussion about art and artists, exploring how art has contributed to the culture, creativity and the wealth of our nation. ✓ Help pupils to recognise that art can be a vehicle for contemplation, reflection, expression of one's identity and can be therapeutic, supporting self-worth and promoting personal wellbeing. 	<p>Our curriculum for art and design is implemented by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Following the statutory National Curriculum which underpins both our planning and the delivery of lessons. ✓ The delivery of lessons which follow the non-statutory 'Kappow' units of work. ✓ Providing opportunities for further cross-curricular thematic lessons, as indicated, on year group curriculum maps. ✓ The delivery of carefully considered units of work which build on prior knowledge and skills. ✓ Offering pupils with high quality stimuli, examples of work and teacher modelling. ✓ Providing pupils with exciting and memorable experiences. ✓ Providing opportunities for the study of historical and current artists and their work in order to inspire, pose questions, reflect and discuss their preferences. ✓ Providing additional thematic arts days and weeks which are delivered across the whole school. ✓ Providing additional thematic based in-house art competitions across the whole school. 	<p>The impact of art and design lessons at Ashwell School will be seen through:</p> <p>Pupils who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Are enthusiastic about art lessons and demonstrate interest and engagement. ✓ Link their learning of art and design to their learning of other cross-curricular theses, topics and projects. ✓ Confidently discuss personal observations and opinions based on their own interpretations of the work of historical and modern-day artists. ✓ Use and apply technical vocabulary when describing their own work and the work of others. ✓ Develop their proficiency across drawing, painting and sculpture based work. ✓ Value the processes they experience as well as final pieces that they, and others have created and generated. ✓ Develop their creativity and critical thinking when overcoming challenges. ✓ Pupils talking proactively and keenly about their learning and experiences
