<p>Our MfL curriculum intends to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Encourage a love for learning languages. ✓ Provide a rich and engaging curriculum (through Language Angels), which allows children to hear correct pronunciations, practice French sayings/sounds, sing songs and write in French. ✓ Encourage children to be reflective learners about our country/continent – provide children with an understanding of other cultures and languages. ✓ Develop a further confidence in children’s oracy and literacy across an additional language and learn new grammatical and linguistic concepts. ✓ Allow the children to develop a new perspective on their 1st language. ✓ Give the children opportunities to tackle unknown languages with increased confidence and accuracy. 	<p>Our curriculum for MfL is implemented by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Use of Language Angels (From year 3-6), but with some exposure in KS1. ✓ Weekly lessons for LKS2 and UKS2 (30 mins a week) ✓ Following the statutory National Curriculum which supports both planning and delivery of lessons – alongside Language Angels. ✓ Providing the children ample opportunities to speak, sing and write in French using a multi-sensory approach to learning. ✓ Introducing and promote use of new vocabulary using a range of classroom resources. ✓ Exploring patterns and sounds (phonics) 	<p>The impact of MfL lessons at Ashwell School will be seen through:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Increased confidence in speaking another language. ✓ Understanding the importance of learning another language, other than their mother tongue – languages differ from one to the other. ✓ An enriched curriculum, helping to create enthusiastic learners and to develop positive attitudes to language learning throughout life. ✓ Developed learning of a language and a deeper understanding of a different culture. ✓ Good progression of linguistic skills and knowledge from the MfL National Curriculum.
