Our School Aims

Our aim is to work in partnership with parents to prepare each child, academically and socially, for a lifetime's learning. We will do our best to provide a caring and stimulating environment through a broad and balanced curriculum within which children can grow in confidence and self-discipline.

The School will:

- ✚ care for the child's safety and happiness, listening to his/her needs
- ✚ provide a broad, balanced curriculum that meets the needs of all children
- ✚ ensure that your child plays a full part as a valued member of the school community
- ✚ ensure that your child achieves the highest standards of achievement in both learning and behaviour
- ✚ keep you informed about school matters, about your child's progress and welfare and to report any safeguarding concerns we may have
- ✚ listen to parents, seek their views and act on feedback where necessary
- ✚ approach every communication in a respectful way
- ✚ safeguard children during the school day 8.45am to 3.15pm and act immediately on any safeguarding concerns raised outside of the school day.
- ✚ monitor electronic communications between all stakeholders to ensure a safe online environment
- ✚ hold at least two parent consultation evenings each year and provide an annual written report card for all full-time pupils

Parents/Guardians will:

- ✚ adhere to the school's attendance policy by:
 - ✚ ensuring that my child goes to school regularly, on time (doors open at 8.40am)
 - ✚ ensure holidays are not taken during the school term or, if unavoidable, that prior permission is sought
 - ✚ contact the school on the first day of my child's absence (before 9.00am)
- ✚ ensure my child adheres to the schools Uniform Policy, is **appropriately** dressed and has PE kit at school
- ✚ support the school's safeguarding, child protection and behaviour policies
- ✚ attend parent's evenings and discussions about my child's progress
- ✚ take an interest in my child's life at school
- ✚ approach every communication in a respectful way
- ✚ demonstrate positive and supportive behaviours and good sportsmanship when attending school events
- ✚ support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community
- ✚ safeguard my child outside the school day (before 8:40am and after 3:15pm)
- ✚ let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- ✚ support the schools Homework Policy by ensuring my child completes the core homework expectations and supports with opportunities for home learning

Pupils will:

- ✚ ensure excellent attendance, getting to school on time (8.40am), **appropriately** dressed and with the right equipment – ready for learning
- ✚ make good choices at all times that enable staff to keep them safe
- ✚ demonstrate excellent attitudes towards learning (classwork and homework)
- ✚ follow the school's Golden Rules and School Values (a copy of which is printed overleaf)
- ✚ show respect for all, at all times, towards all members of the school community and visitors
- ✚ speak to a trusted adult about any concerns that they have
- ✚ look after and take care of our school environment, equipment and other people's property
- ✚ support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community

As a school community we will:

- ✚ communicate respectfully and effectively
- ✚ be respectful and understanding towards others individual beliefs, differences and needs
- ✚ work collaboratively with children's interests at the heart of everything we do
- ✚ deal sensitively with any concerns or complaints in line with the Complaints Policy
- ✚ support the activities of the Parent Teacher Association (PTA)
